In this life, many of us face challenges that seem impossible to us. One of those impossible challenges was when God called me to be a preacher. I was horrified to imagine myself preaching in front of the church every Sunday. I was quick to point out my inadequacies. Like Moses in Exodus 4:10, my excuse to God was that I would stutter and freak out in front of a crowd. I also rationalised that I was less eloquent than many others. Besides, I was an introvert, hardly talking to any strangers. Above all, I was more interested in making money as a businessman than working for the church as a pastor. It would be a miracle for me to obey that calling. However, God knew better what was better for me. He would not accept a "no" from me. He further assured me that he would empower me by his Spirit. Fast-forward forty years later, I know God has not failed in his promise. Like George Muller proclaimed, "If God ever fails, this is the first time." By his grace, God has empowered me through my stuttering to fulfil his calling.

Today, God is still calling many to serve him. No matter how impossible it may seem to us, God will empower all through our "stuttering" to fulfil our individual calling. As you read this, do you sense a call from God? I pray that you will allow the Lord to empower you to take the first step to obeying your vocational calling.

Witness and Discipleship in a Digital Age

God places the church in a rapidly changing globalized world for His purpose- for man to come to a loving relationship with Him and with others in the community of faith. In Col 1:28-29, Christ "is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ. To this end, we strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in us". Learning from the apostle Paul in Ac 20:20, who preached and taught publicly from house to house, in this 5G era, we should maximize technology in advancing the Gospel from house to house.

The recent data report from Social and Hootsuite's latest Global Digital Insights (released in July 2022) shows that 5.03 billion people are using the internet. Worldwide, there were 4.70 billion social media users. Globally, more than 5.34 billion people use mobile phones, with almost 67 percent of the world's total population now using some kind of mobile phone¹. Locally, Social and Hootsuite's *Digital 2022: Singapore* also indicates an increasing number of internet users. There were 5.45 million internet users, 5.3 million social media users, and 8.7 million mobile connections in Singapore in January 2022². Internet technology has profoundly influenced our daily lives.

Globally, Christian leaders are urged to integrate media engagement into their mission strategies³. Like many scholars, Sam George has encouraged the church to discover new ways of engaging with the world in mission and making a difference⁴. Indeed, from the Old to the New Testaments, we observe many uses of technology to further God's purposes, for example, in Ex 36:1: "the LORD has given skill and ability to know how to carry out all the work of constructing the sanctuary". The affordances of technology are useful if the church maximizes mobile technology for witnessing and discipleship to advance God's mission. Rob Haskell proposed that there are also many opportunities to expand healthy relationships and evangelism in the new virtual world⁵. He encourages the church to take hold of this golden opportunity to reach out and make disciples.


Witness and Discipleship in a Digital Age

Cyber communications have taken a lead role in large-scale media outreach to the lost⁶. Now, technology opens multiple mediums for evangelism. It allows the church to reach beyond geographical boundaries with the gospel. It also allows the church to target specific locations or specific people groups. People can interact with the Gospel profoundly through mobile technology. It has been observed that, with mobile technology, more laities are involved in missions⁷.

Besides, online collaboration systems enable a larger virtual team of people to work together. Currently, most people who are engaged in teaching, discipleship programs, evangelism do so online, through video, audio, and literary media. This digital formation extends the reach of learning and can provide a context for an interactive learning community that is spiritually formative⁸. Maximizing technology in teaching is essential, especially for visual learners; technology is a vital part of teaching. The benefits of using online learning are: facilitating broader participation, exploring the learners' context or social location, helping students engage in a critical reading of texts, discovering the cooperative character of learning, encouraging wider questioning, and leading in the formation process⁹.

The challenge now is for church leaders to engage in collaborative reflection on how the church can equip and resource Christians to engage critically with and respond constructively to all forms of media in evangelism and discipleship. Therefore, Christian community ought to take the lead and stay on the cutting edge of technology, rethink our modern engagement strategies and reallocate resources to respond to this rapidly changing digital world.

神把教会放在一个瞬息万变的全球化世界中以完成祂的旨意,即让人与祂修复爱的关系。在西1:28-29中提到,"我们传扬【基督】,是用各样的智慧,劝戒各人,教导各人,为了要使各人在基督里得到完全。我们要为了这事劳苦,按着他用大能在我们心中运行的动力,竭力奋斗。"在这个5G时代,我们可学习保罗在Ac 20:20中挨家挨户地讲道和公开教导,我们将最大限度地利用这新科技在家与家之间广传福音。

社交和Hootsuite在2022年7月发布的最新全球数字洞察的最新数据报告显示,有50.3 亿人正在使用互联网。截至2022年7月初,全球有47亿社交媒体用户。在全球范围内,超过53.4亿人使用手机,目前全球总人口的近67%使用某种手机¹。在本地,社交和Hootsuite的*数字2022:新加坡* "表明互联网用户数量不断增加。2022年1月,新加坡有545万互联网用户、530万社交媒体用户和870万移动连接²。

在全球范围内,基督徒领袖被敦促将媒体参与纳入他们的宣教策略³。像许多学者一样,山姆·乔治(Sam George)鼓励教会探索与世界接轨的新方式,并做出改变⁴。事实上,从《旧约》到《新约》,我们观察到许多利用技术来促进上帝的目的,例如,在Ex 36:1中:"耶和华赐与智慧与聪明,使他们知道怎样制造供圣所使用的一切工程的人"。如果教会最大限度地利用移动技术进行见证和门徒训练,以推进神的使命,那么技术的启示是有用的。Rob Haskell提出,在新的虚拟世界中,也有很多机会拓展健康的关系和福音⁵。他鼓励教会抓住这个千载难逢的机会,外展,培养门徒。



网络传播在大规模媒体向未信者传播中发挥了主导作用⁶。现在,科技为福音传播打开了多种媒体。此外,科技使教会能够超越地理界限,针对特定地点或特定人群传播福音。人们可以通过科技与福音进行深刻的互动。据观察,随着移动技术的发展,更多的平信徒参与了宣教工作⁷。

此外,在线协作系统网络使更大的虚拟团队能够协同工作。目前,大多数人通过视频、音频和文学媒体在线从事教学、门徒训练和福音传教。这种数字化的形式扩展了学习的范围,可以为一个具有属灵塑造的交互式学习社区提供一个环境⁸。在教学中最大限度地利用科技至关重要,尤其是对于视觉学习者而言;科技是教学的重要组成部分。使用在线学习的好处是:促进更广泛的参与;探索学习者的背景或社会位置;帮助学生批判性阅读文本;发现学习的合作特征;鼓励更广泛的提问;引导形成学习过程⁹。

教会领袖现在面临的挑战是,如何协同思考教会如何装备和资源基督徒,以批判性地参与并建设性地回应各种形式的传福音和门徒训练媒体。因此,我们敦促基督教社群发挥带头作用,走在科技的前沿,重新思考我们的现代参与策略,并重新分配资源,以应对这个快速变化的数字世界。

The retreat concluded with a sunrise service by the beach. Even as we ended the retreat, each going back to our individual churches and ministry, we were reminded to practice what we have learnt over the past three days, with our hearts "facing the east", waiting for the return of Jesus.

DMN855: LEADERSHIP IN THE 21ST CENTURY ASIAN CONTEXT

3 CREDITS

Intended to provide an overview of leadership in the 21st. Century in an Asian context. Conflict resolution in Christian organizations with an emphasis on the cross-cultural basis of conflict is discussed. The need for change in the fast paced world in which we live as well as colliding cultures are examined. The emergence of the missional church and the part it plays in the post-modern world are analyzed.
